"Why Quality?"

Waste; failures of products, programs and services; and incompetent leadership are destructive to individuals, organizations, governments, businesses, hospitals, schools, nations and global society. The Quality Sciences, founded after World War II, are dedicated to make actions constructive, productive and to reduce their quantitative and qualitative costs.

In 2010 human and environmental problems are increasing globally. That appears to be a counter intuitive dilemma for Quality Managers. What does that mean for today's evaluation of the Quality Sciences? The Founder of the Policy Sciences, in the 1960s, Professor Yehezkel Dror created his Dror's Law #1 in 1971 that has remained accurate over the past four decades and provides one important answer. Dror's Law #1 states:

*"While the difficulties and dangers of problems tend to increase
At a geometric rate, the number of persons qualified to deal
With these problems tends to increase at an arithmetic rate."*
